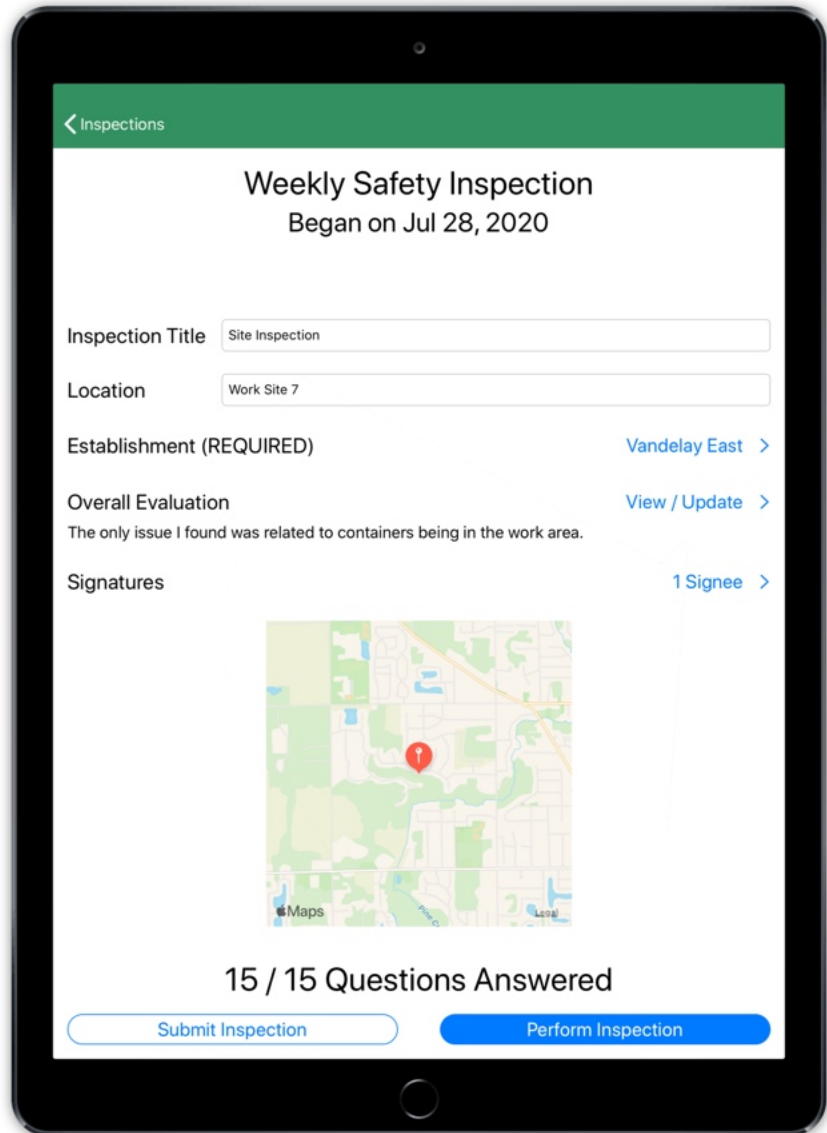
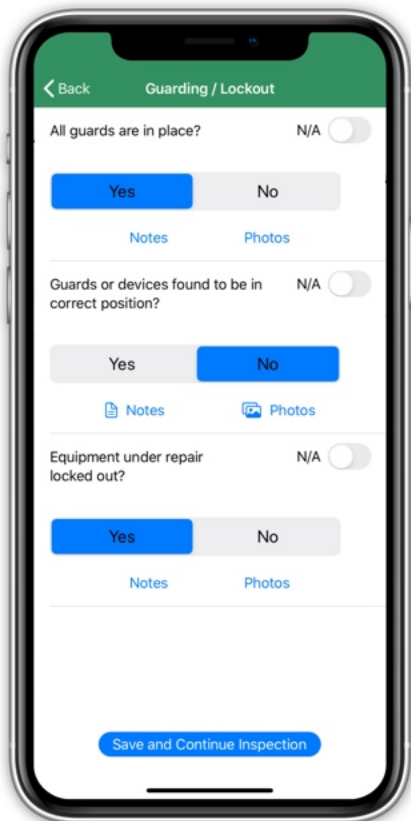

1. Mobile Inspection App

 - Toolbox talks (with attendee signatures)
 - Hazard analysis (JSA / JHA)
 - Confined Space Entry Permits ... and more
- Document findings with notes and pictures
- Share inspection results and resolve findings
- Operate in off-line mode (no cell service)



2. Training Tracker

- Ensure your teams have the training they need when they need it
- System generated training plan includes courses needed and suggested attendees
- Dashboard lists upcoming courses along with team members with training that has expired or is set to expire
- Schedule courses, sign up attendees, record attendance

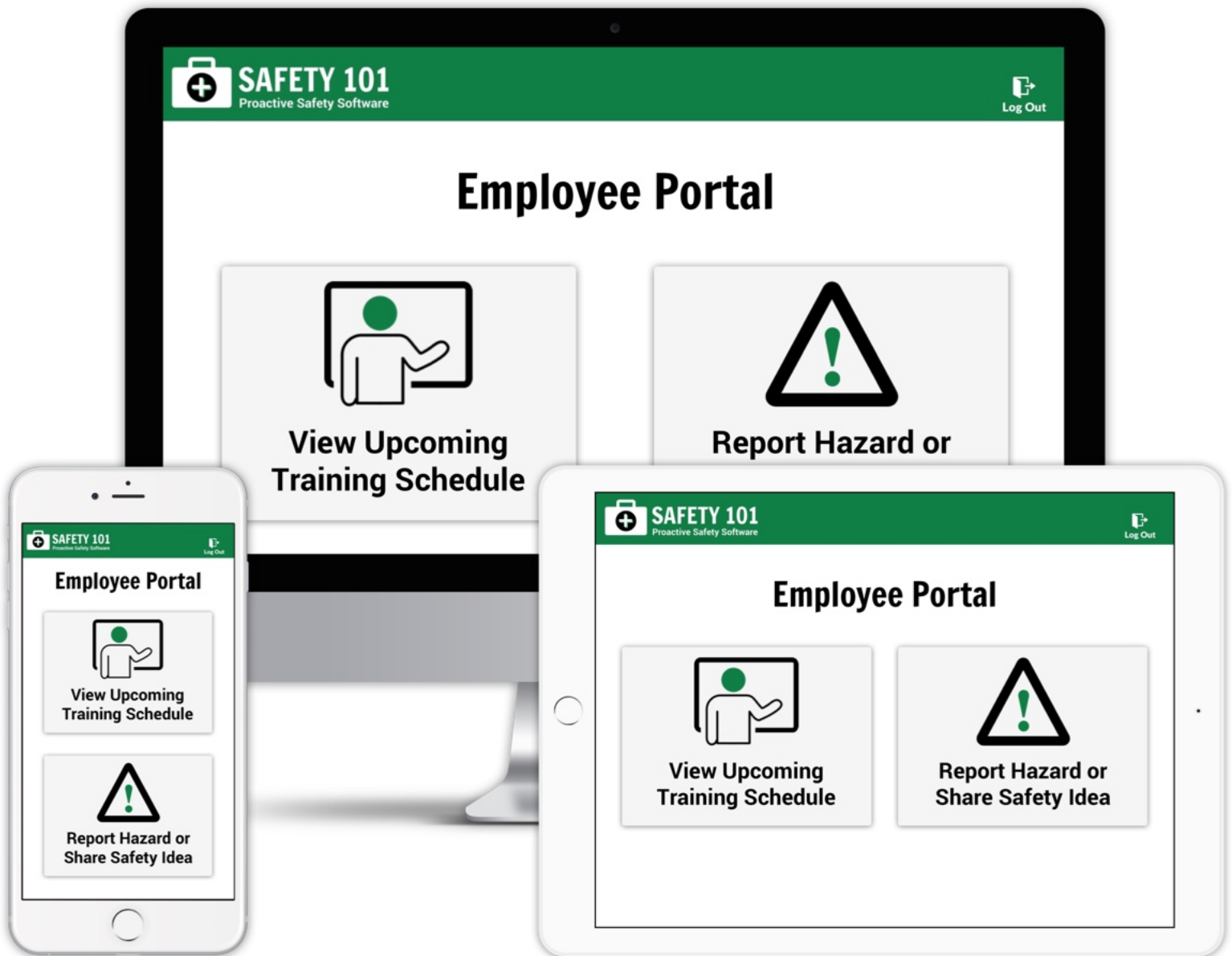

Main Content Area:

- Observed Hazard**
A safety hazard that has been observed but did not result in a near miss or OSHA recordable incident. May be uncovered with a regular safety audit by a safety committee member or by employees that notice the potential risk for injury.
- Near Miss (No Injury)**
An accident that did not result in serious injury, illness, or damage – but had the potential to do so. A person was not hurt and first-aid was not administered.
- Minor Injury**
An accident that did not result in serious injury, illness, or damage. A person was hurt and first-aid may have been administered but the injury or illness was not serious enough to be logged as an OSHA recordable incident. **Select**
- Serious Injury (OSHA Recordable)**
A serious work-related injury or illness that normally requires medical attention beyond first-aid. May have resulted in employee's loss of consciousness, days away from work, restricted work, or transfer to another job.

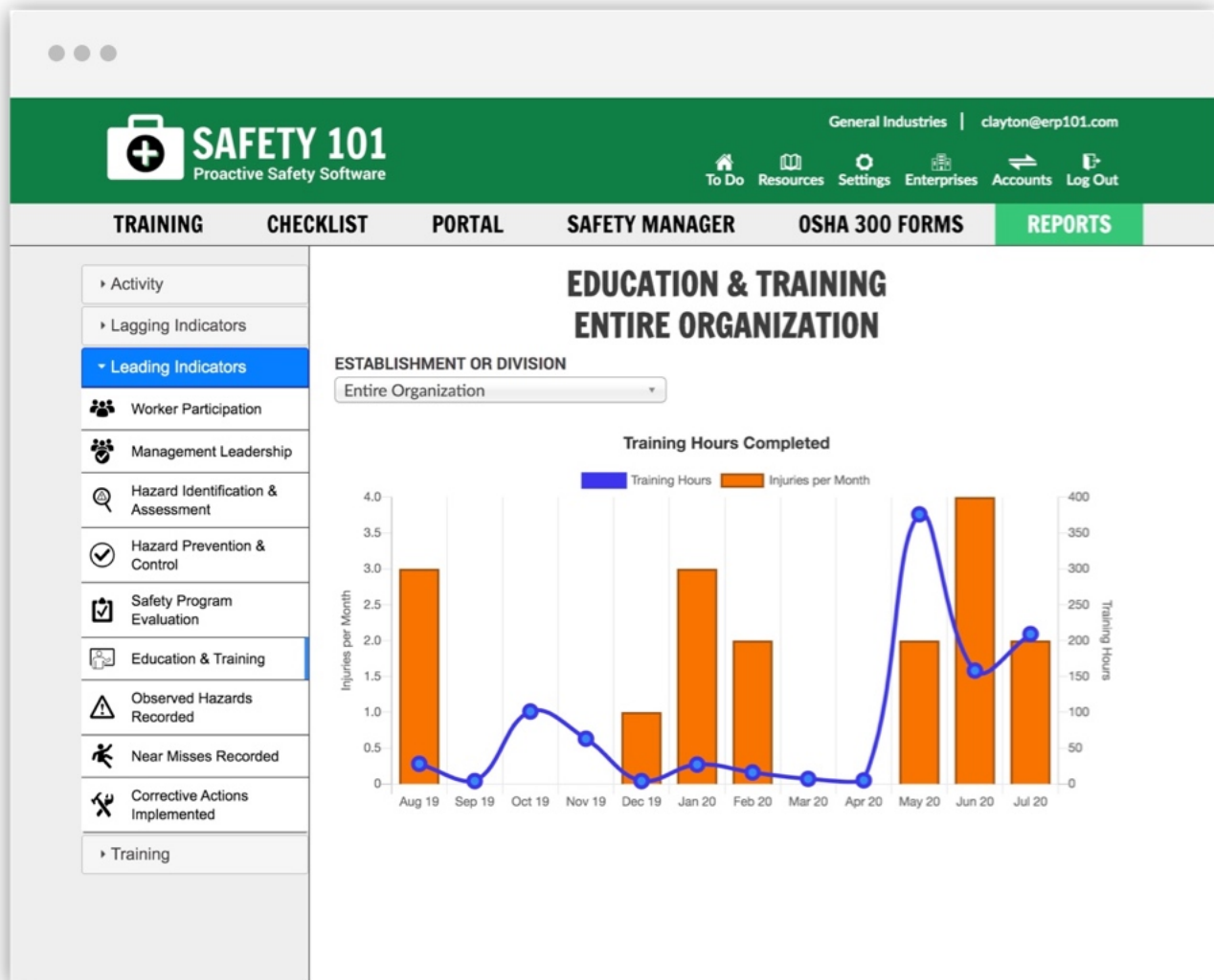
